Duraisamy Nadar Maragathavalli Ammal, for the benefit of a hundreds of generations of women folk in and around the coastal town of Nagapattinam.

The college offers a wide range of programmes in Arts, Science and Commerce at both Under Graduate and Post Graduate level. At Present 16 U.G. programmes, 08 P.G. programmes, 03 M.Phil & 06 Ph.D. programmes in various groups of Arts, Science and Commerce are offered to the students. This academic year commenced on 16.06.2017. The college has both Aided and Self Financing sections. This year the total students' strength is 1879. They are supported by 120 teaching faculty and 57 Non-teaching and administrative staff.
