INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL

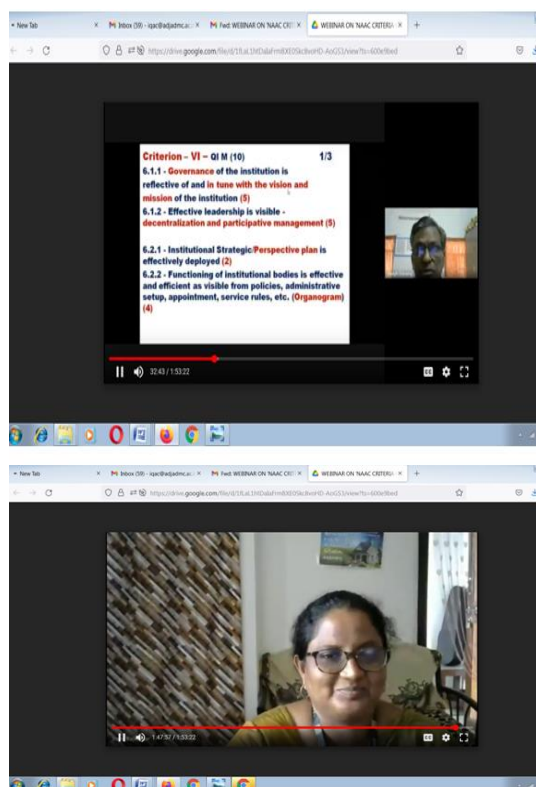
IQAC convened meeting on 19th January 2021 with the department representative members.

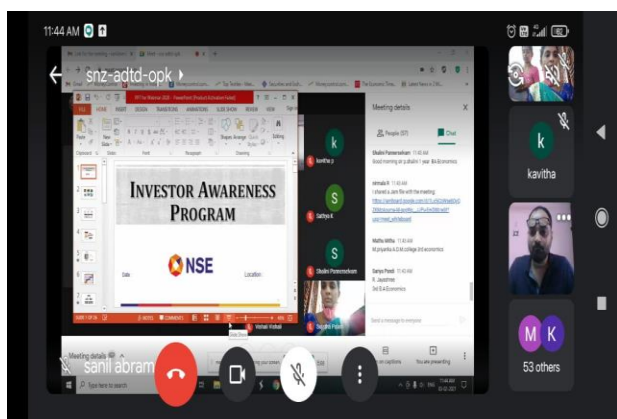

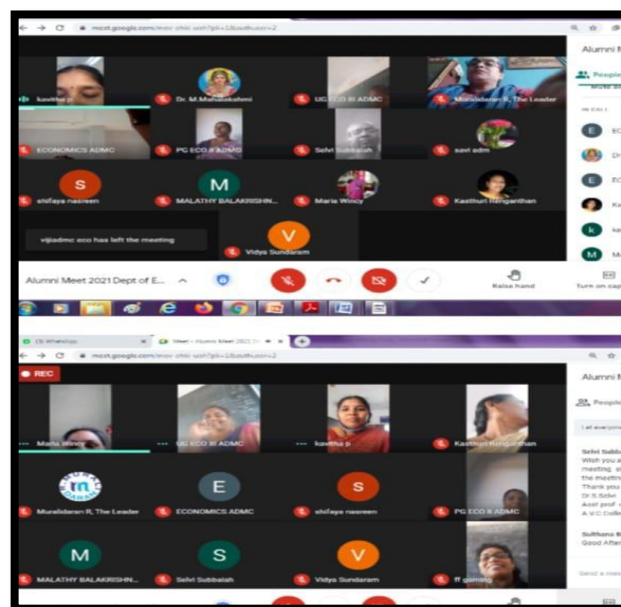

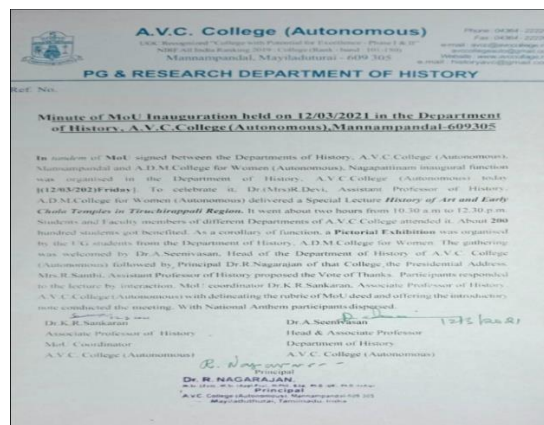

ALUMNI MEET 18.03.21

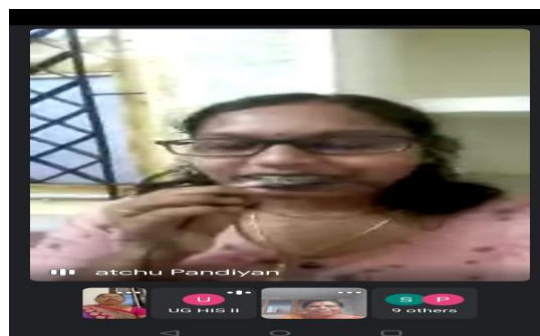

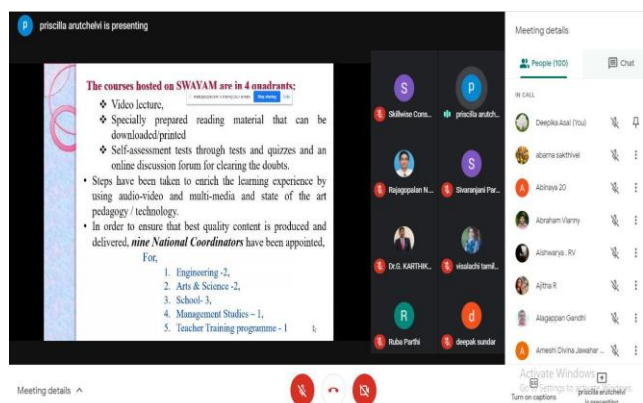
