

## COMPETITIVE COACHING CENTRE – REPORT 2019-2022

### ODD Semester:

This Cell conducted TNPSC Group IV coaching for the third year students from 19.06.2019 to 22.08.2019 in all working days during 1.30 p.m to 2.00 p.m. The teaching faculties from various departments handled the classes with full effort in an interesting manner. Fifteen of our third year students enthusiastically attended the classes regularly and benefitted.

NET/ SET coaching is applicable only for II PG students. Mrs.Prabavathy, Mrs.P.Hameetha Begum and Dr.K.Prasanna Devi, Assistant Professors of Mathematics handled the NET/ SET coaching for the II M.Sc students during 1.30 p.m and 2.00 p.m in alternate working days in the Odd Semester. Mrs.S.Rajeshwari, Head and Associate Professor of Economics and Dr.R.Kasthuri, Assistant Professor of Economics handled the NET/ SET coaching for II M.A Economics students. In the same way, Ms.Gokila, Assistant Professor of Commerce handled the NET/ SET coaching for the II M.Com students.

Competitive Examinations Cell motivated C.Monika of II M.Sc Mathematics to attend a 6 days' workshop on "Cracking NET/ SET Questions" at Periyar Maniammai Institute of Science & Technology, Thanjavur from 23.09.19 to 28.09.19. With this effective coaching, she attended NBHM exam on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2019 confidently and scored 86 points.

### EVEN Semester:

(i) Competitive Examinations Cell organised a seminar on the topic "A Motivational Speech on Competitive Examinations" for the third year students on 17.12.2019 from 11.00 a.m to 12.45 p.m in our college premises. Mr.Ramesh Aditya, Head, Strategy, Shankar IAS Academy gave a brief introduction about the Academy. Mr.Sucharithan, faculty, Shankar IAS Academy gave a vast and clear explanation about the various stages followed up in UPSC & TNPSC Examinations and the attempts to be made in the exams. About 200 students attended the programme and got a clear idea about the competitive Examinations.



(ii) The Certificate Course Committee and Competitive Examinations Cell jointly organized a five days' Programme on Competitive Examinations coaching for the third year students, who were interested in higher studies, to crack the competitive Examinations. The Programme was conducted on 07.01.2020, 08.01.2020, 09.01.2020, 25.01.2020 and 01.02.2020. The Resource persons were Mr. Franklin and Mrs. Sophia Franklin from LENOEDX, Chennai. Around 250 students attended this programme. They gave introduction about the aptitude tests, their aspects and also explained how to apply for the various competitive examinations to the students. They taught the students to solve the problems on the topics Logical Reasoning which includes Blood Relation, Directions, Coding & Decoding, Numerical systems, Averages, Problems on Ages and Profit & Loss, Relationship, Odd one out, Analogy, Time & Work, Chain Rule, Percentage, Calendar, Ratio & Proportions, Square roots, Speed & Distance. They shared many techniques and tricks to solve the problems. The students gave their valuable feedback about the classes they attended and expressed their thanks to the Management and the Principal for arranging such a useful coaching classes.

### **ODD SEMESTER:**

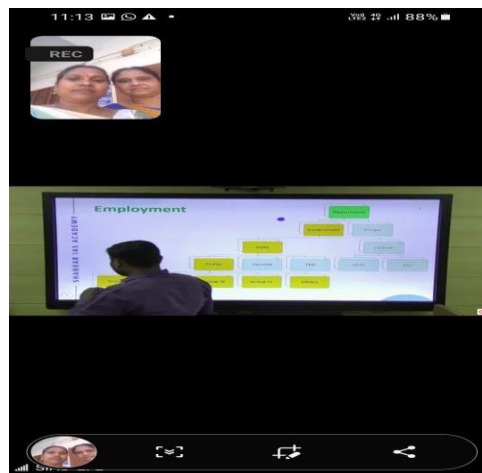
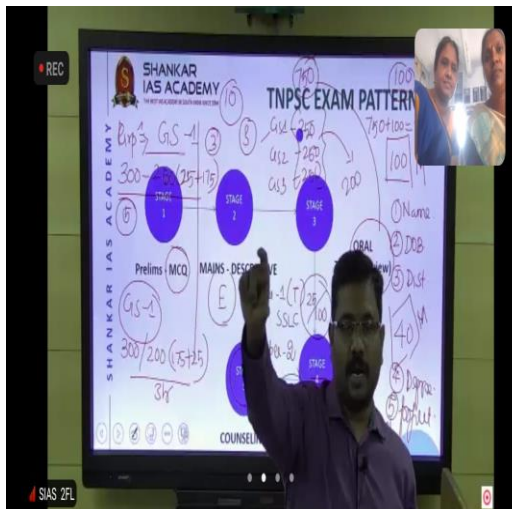
### **EVEN SEMESTER:**
